INQUIRY QUESTION

READ...

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WATCH...

Watch the video about the Catholic Mission's Interfaith Program, then discuss how the program promotes peace and understanding among different faiths.

...and be moved!

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LISTEN...

After listening to *'Is Peace on Earth Possible?'* Ask yourself the same thought-provoking question to spark reflection and discussion.

HEAD

- In groups, students choose a country or place currently experiencing conflict, poverty, or injustice.
- What's happening?
- Who is affected?
- Have students write a short reflection (1-2 paragraphs) that addresses how peace may be achieved.



HEART

- Zambia's motto is "One Nation, One People, One Zambia." What do you think this means?
- If you could write a motto for Australia, what would it be? Why?



HANDS

- Pair up students and challenge them to complete one peaceful act for each other during the week (helping, listening, including others).
- At the end of the week, reflect how they brought each other peace.
