HEAD

- Research Malawi and explore what challenges communities are currently facing?

HEART

- Why do you think hope is important during difficult times?
- What can we learn from the resilience of people in Malawi?
- How can young people promote peace and justice in their own communities?
- Why is it important to learn about the lives and experiences of others around the world?



HANDS

- Ask students to write:
 - A way they will bring peace this week
 - An action they can take at school
 - One way they can support others
- Students place responses on a classroom wall or "peace board."
