

MON 24 OCT



- School-wide assembly introducing Mission Week, sharing about work of Catholic Mission and progress in Socktober so far (or plans for engagement)
- Guest Speaker (Catholic Mission staff, Champion Teacher, Ambassador, etc.) to speak at assembly
- → Hand out resources and/or brochures, encouraging registration and participation
- → Play Socktober in Under 3 Minutes video and share about Ethiopia project focus

TUE 25 OCT ACTIVITY DAY

- In class, students are split into groups to work through Mission Packs 1-2, choosing activities to complete.
 Students can present their work in teams.
- Students can make their own sockballs from recycled materials as one of these tasks.

CHILDREN'S MISSION DAY

- Students focus on Ethiopia and learn about the country, its people, and the issues they are raising funds for. Watch the Mission in 360 video to support learning.
- → Work on Mission Packs 3-4, choosing some activities and reflections to complete.
- Hold a school-wide Mission Mass or Liturgy, join a diocesan-wide event, or tune into the national Mass.

THU 27 OCT ACTIVITY DAY

- Students work on Mission Packs 5-6, preparing for the Socktober Event Day and finalizing their fundraising asks.
- Complete Sockball making exercise and share on school social media before Friday.
- Homework activity: Write a letter to a family in Emdibir.

FRI 28 OCT



FAIR DAY

- → Hold a plain-clothes mission fete day at school with a gold coin sausage sizzle / bake stall etc.
- Host a Socktober Shootout activity during the morning or at lunchtime. Invite parents to join as volunteers and encourage students to use their sockballs.
- Debrief on sockball activity and connect to Ethiopia and fundraising
- Hold an assembly to congratulate students on their Socktober efforts and thank parents.
